## **Norfolk & Norwich Open Studios**

### **Information for schools**

Norfolk & Norwich Open Studios (NNOS) takes place annually. Artists across the county open up their studio doors during a 16-day period in May/June to meet the public and show and sell their work, thereby maintaining and broadening the audience for local visual arts work. In 2018, an estimated 36,000 members of the public roamed the county to visit over 460 participating artists in 257 studios.

Since 2010 the scheme has been opened up to include Norfolk Schools and in 2018, 16 Norfolk schools were involved and they received an estimated 1,259 visitors overall.

Entry to studios is free for members of the public.

### **What schools need to do to be part of NNOS**

- Open their school and/or other exhibition venue to the public for a minimum of one day or evening, at times of their own choosing during NNOS 2019 dates (Saturday 25 May – Sunday 9 June)
- Exhibit any visual arts work that pupils at the school have produced during the last school year. This can be final pieces of work or even work in progress. What you show and how you show it is up to you – the more imaginative or interactive, the better.
- Exhibit work by pupils in the school itself or at an external venue

### **Promotion of NNOS Schools**

All participating schools will feature in the NNOS brochure (print run of 35,000) and on the NNOS website. NNOS branded posters and postcards are also produced and distributed across the county, and articles published in the local press. Each participating school is also expected to promote their own event(s) with the help of a schools' marketing pack, supplied by the NNOS office.

### **NNOS School Taster Exhibition & Arts Award Discover**

All participating schools have the opportunity to exhibit in the 'NNOS School Taster Exhibition' held at a venue in central Norwich. The exhibition works as a preview of the scheme and of Norfolk children's artwork.

Alongside this exhibition we offer a special event or workshop for schools to attend which will include an opportunity for young people to gain their [Arts Award Discover](#).

The fee for schools to participate in the scheme is £110 (inc. VAT), and is the same as individual artist fees. The fee contributes towards costs of producing the brochure, website and website support, other marketing materials, postage and distribution.
